CHAPTER 347.

AN ACT to incorporate the South West Bend Stage Company.

Approved February 26, 1833.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That Jonathan C. Merrill, Israel Putnam, Jonathan Judkins, Olando Merrill, William Newell Jr., Josiah Libbey, Joseph Moore and Ebenezer Ham and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the South West Bend Stage Company, for the purpose of establishing and continuing a line of Stages from Portland to Augusta by the South West Bend; with power to prosecute and defend suits at law; to have a common seal, and to change the same, to make any by-laws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to the laws of this State; to take and hold any real and personal estate to the value of Five Thousand Dollars; and to give, grant, bargain and sell the same; and with all the privileges usually granted to similar Corporations.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That Ebenezer Ham may call the first meeting of said Corporation, at such time and place as by him may be designated, by posting up notice thereof in the towns of Durham, Wales and Monmouth seven days at least previous thereto.
