JANUARY SESSION, 1833.

Chapter 1.

Resolve for the preservation of the documents printed by order of the Legislature.

Approved January 24, 1833.

Resolved, That the Clerk of the House of Representatives during each session of the Legislature retain twenty copies of every document printed by order of either branch of the Legislature and at the end of each session cause the same to be bound for the use of the Legislature of this State—And that the Governor with the advice of Council is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for the expense incurred for binding the same.

Chapter 2.

Resolve, respecting the Senators of the United States from the State of Maine.

Approved January 26, 1833.

In consideration that the Legislature of Maine, at the last Session, after mature deliberation and as the known will of the people, instructed the Senators of this State in Congress to oppose and vote against a renewal of the
