Chapter 31.

Resolve for the benefit of George F. Richardson.

Approved February 15, 1833.

Resolved, That there be paid, out of the Treasury of the State, to George F. Richardson, the sum of Five Dollars, in full remuneration for a sum of money by him paid, and trouble and expense by him incurred, in redeeming from a sale for non-payment of taxes, wrongfully assessed thereon for the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty one, a tract of land, called and known by the name of township numbered four in the County of Oxford, between Bingham's Kennebec Purchase and the New Hampshire State line.

Chapter 32.

Resolve for the purchase and distribution of Williamson's History of Maine.

Approved February 20, 1833.

Resolved, That the Secretary of State is hereby authorized to purchase of William D. Williamson, Esq. three hundred and fifty copies of his History of Maine, in two volumes each, at a price not exceeding Four Dollars per copy.

Resolved, That the Governor and Council are hereby authorized to draw their warrant upon the Treasurer of the State, for the necessary sum to pay said Williamson for

the said copies of the History of Maine.

Resolved, That it shall be the duty of the Secretary of State, after having made the purchase aforesaid, forthwith to transmit to the Clerk of each town and organized plantation and of the City of Portland one copy, in two volumes, of the aforesaid History, for the use of said town, plantation and city.
