Chapter 61.

Resolve for the payment of accounts against the State.

Approved February 28, 1833.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State, out of any moneys not otherwise appropriated, to the several persons mentioned in Roll number fourteen, the sums set against such persons' names respectively, amounting in the whole to the sum of Fifteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and Two Cents, in full discharge of the accounts and demands to which they refer.
