Chapter 66.

Resolve providing for building a Bridge in the town of Brownville.

Approved March 2, 1833.

Resolved, That the County Commissioners of the County of Penobscot, be and hereby are authorized to appropriate a sum not exceeding Six Hundred Dollars, to build or defray the expense of building a Bridge over pleasant River in the town of Brownville in said County, and said Commissioners are hereby authorized to order said sum to be paid out by the Treasurer of said County.

Chapter 67.

Resolve for the removal of a Gun-House in Hallowell.

Approved March 2, 1833.

Resolved, That the Adjutant General, if in his opinion it shall be expedient, be and he hereby is authorized to cause the Gun-House in Hallowell to be removed from its present location to such other site as he may think suitable; and also to sell and convey the lot of land on which said Gun-House stands. *Provided* the avails of said lot shall amount to a sum sufficient for the purchase of a new site and for the expenses of the removal aforesaid.
