Chapter 94.

Resolve in favor [of] Theodore Bean.

Approved March 4, 1833.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Theodore Bean for his services as Adjutant in the second Regiment second Brigade and seventh Division for the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Twenty Five Dollars his account for the same having been certified by the Colonel of said Regiment.

Chapter 95.

Resolve on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Approved March 4, 1833.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of the State, to the several persons named in the preceding Roll, the sums set against their respective names, amounting to Twenty Five Thousand, Five Hundred and Fifty one Dollars.

Chapter 96.

A Resolve in addition to a Resolve respecting the territory lying North and East of the Rivers St. John and St. Francis, approved the third day of March in the year eighteen hundred and thirty two.

Resolved, That so much of the Resolve passed the third day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two, entitled a "Resolve respecting the territory lying North and East of the Rivers St. Johns
