Duty of orderly officer to prosecute therefor.

Provido.

said orderly officer or Adjutant—and it is hereby made the duty of said orderly officer when the delinquent is an officer in his Brigade—and of said Adjutant when the delinquent is an officer or musician in his Regiment or Battalion, to prosecute therefor—*Provided*, however, that no action shall be sustained against any such officer or musician, when the commanding officer of the Brigade, Regiment or Battalion, to which said officer or musician belongs, shall certify to said orderly officer or Adjutant, that in his opinion, there was a sufficient and satisfactory reason for said neglect or refusal.

Compensation of Aids-de-camp, &c.

SECT. 7. *Be it further enacted*, That instead of the compensation heretofore allowed to the officers hereafter named, the following sums shall be allowed in full for the services required of them respectively: viz. to each Aid-de-Camp, acting as orderly officer to the Major General, each Division Inspector, each Brigade Inspector and Aid-de-Camp, each Adjutant of Cavalry or Artillery, ten dollars, and each Adjutant of Regiment fifteen dollars.

Former Acts repealed.

SECT. 8. *Be it further enacted*, That all acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same hereby are repealed.
