CHAPTER 452.

AN ACT to incorporate the Lebanon Stage Company.

Approved February 21, 1834.

SECT. 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Oliver Stackpole, Samuel Persons int-Pray, Alexander Worcester, John Libbey, Jeremiah Libbey, corporated. Increase S. Kimball, Hauley A. Keay, Nathaniel Butler, Daniel Ward Junior, and Abram Hanscom and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they hereby are incorporated into a body politic, by the name of the Lebanon Stage and purposes of Company, for the purpose of establishing and continuing incorporation. a line of stages from Dover through Berwick, North Berwick, Lebanon, Sanford, Shapleigh, Acton, Newfield to Effingham in the State of New Hampshire ; with power to sue and be sued; to have a common seal, to make any by- Powers, privilaws for the management of their affairs, not repugnant to leges, &c. the laws of the State, to take and hold any estate real and personal to the value of Five Thousand Dollars, and to grant, sell and convey the same, and with all the powers and privileges usually granted to similar corporations.

SECT. 2. Be it further enacted, That Oliver Stackpole, Mode of calling and Increase S. Kimball or either of them may call the first meeting. first meeting of said corporation at such time and place as by either of them may be designated and in such manner as they or either of them may consider proper.
