 CHAPTER 475.

AN ACT to incorporate the Belfast Screw Dock Company.

Approved March 4, 1834.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That* Ephraim T. Morrill, Samuel French, Samuel Jackson, Junior, John Haraden and Abraham Libbey with their associates and successors be and hereby are created a corporation by the name of the Belfast Screw Dock Company, for the purpose of repairing vessels, and also of engaging in such other branches of business as may be necessarily and conveniently connected therewith—And for these purposes, shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and requirements expressed in an Act defining the general powers and duties of manufacturing corporations, passed the eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one, and may take and hold any real or personal estate to an amount not exceeding at any one time in the whole the value of Six Thousand Dollars.

 CHAPTER 476.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Shirley.

Approved March 4, 1834.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That* the township numbered three in the fourth range, Bingham Purchase, on the East side of the Kennebec river in the County of Somerset,
