for the current year ; and the Governor is authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for the above sum, or such part thereof as shall be required, to be paid from any moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Chapter 29.

Resolve respecting the State Prison.

Approved February 28, 1834.

Resolved, That the Governor by and with the advice of the Council be and hereby is authorized to appoint one or more persons not exceeding three, to visit the State Prison at Thomaston, to investigate the conduct of its officers and all the offices and affairs of the Institution, and report to the Governor and Council with all reasonable despatch the result of their investigation. And also their opinion, what, if any, reform or improvement can be made in the Prison—Said Agent or Agents to be paid out of the Treasury from any moneys not otherwise appropriated, such sum for their services as shall appear to the Governor and Council just—And the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Council is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for such amount as shall be allowed said Agent or Agents.

Chapter 30.

Resolve in favor of Sewall Prescott.

Approved February 28, 1834.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the State Treasury the sum of One Hundred and Five Dollars and Sixty Cents to Sewall Prescott, in full for balance due him as Agent for superintending the making of the Canada Road.
