FOURTEENTH LEGISLATURE

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE,

PASSED AT THE SESSION

WHICH COMMENCED ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY, AND ENDED ON
THE THIRTEENTH DAY OF MARCH, ONE THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-FOUR.

Hundred and Five Dollars and Fifty Cents, being Ten Hundred and Fifty Three Dollars and Fifty Cents expended by said Emerson in building a part of the Baring and Houlton road, over lands of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and One Hundred and Fifty Two Dollars being the interest on said sum from the fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one.

Chapter 37.

Resolve in favor of Moses True.

Approved March 4, 1834.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Moses True for services rendered and expenses incurred in locating a road, to connect the United States Military road with the Baring and Houlton road, the sum of Seventy Dollars and Seventy Eight Cents being in addition to the sum of One Hundred Dollars appropriated by virtue of a Resolve, approved March fourth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty three and the Governor with advice of Council is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasury for the same.

Chapter 38.

Resolve in favor of Isaac Hodsdon.

Approved March 5, 1834.

Resolved, That there be paid out of the State Treasury to Isaac Hodsdon the sum of Ten Dollars and Eighty Seven Cents, in full for his services and expenses in the purchase and distribution of musical instruments for the use of eight Regiments of Infantry.
