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**CHAPTER 513.**

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Edinburg.

Approved January 31, 1835.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That River Township No. one in the sixth Range of Townships West of the Penobscot River Old Indian Purchase, with the inhabitants thereof be and the same is hereby incorporated into a town by the name of Edinburg, vested with all the powers, and subject to all the duties, of other incorporated towns of this State.

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**CHAPTER 514.**

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Enfield.

Approved January 31, 1835.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That Treat's Tract, and the remaining part of Township No. One, River Township, East side of Penobscot River, with the inhabitants thereof, be and the same is hereby incorporated into a town by the name of Enfield, vested with all the powers and subject to all the duties of other incorporate towns of this State.
