## BARING BRIDGE.—TOWN OF BRADLEY.

## CHAPTER 519.

AN ADDITIONAL ACT "to incorporate the Baring Bridge."

Approved February 3, 1835.

Further time allowed Proprietors to complete Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That a further time of two years, from and after the passing of this Act, shall be allowed to the Proprietors of the Baring Bridge, to erect and complete the bridge which they were empowered to erect and complete, by an Act of the Legislature of this State, passed the twenty-sixth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, without forfeiting their charter, or losing any powers, privileges or immunities granted them by said Act.

## CHAPTER 520.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Bradley.

Approved February 3, 1835.

Description.

Corporate name.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That Township numbered four, east side of Penobscot River, Old Indian Purchase, with the inhabitants thereof, be and the same hereby is incorporated into a town by the name of Bradley, vested with all the powers and subject to all the duties of other incorporated towns of this State.
