FIFTEENTH LEGISLATURE,

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE,

PASSED AT THE SESSION

Which commenced on the seventh day of January, and ended on the twenty-fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five.

from which returns have been made; and from the sum so deducted there shall be paid to the delinquent towns making returns as aforesaid a sum equal to what they would have been entitled by this Resolve, if they had seasonably made their returns, if said sum shall be sufficient, and the balance of said sum if any shall be carried to the general credit of the State: And if said sum so deducted shall prove insufficient to pay all the delinquent towns, making such returns, to the above amount, then said sum shall be rateably apportioned between them. And the defects or informalities in any of the returns already made shall not bar such City, Town or Plantation making such informal return from receiving its due proportion of said School Fund. And the Secretary of State is hereby directed to notify forthwith the delinquent Towns and Plantations to make their returns by the first day of May next as aforesaid, by forwarding to each of them a copy of this Resolve and a blank return.

Chapter 27.

Resolve relative to the doings of the County Commissioners for the County of Washington.

Approved March 5, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the proceedings of the County Commissioners of the County of Washington, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two, laying out and locating the road from the South line of the Indian Township numbered two in the first range of townships north of the Bingham purchase to the town of Houlton, and their subsequent proceedings, providing for the opening and making the same, be and hereby are confirmed and made valid in law; and said road laid out by them, is hereby established and confirmed as a County road.
