Chapter 45.

Resolve in favor of Edsil Grover.

Approved March 19, 1835.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this State to Edsil Grover, the sum of twenty Dollars for extra expenses incurred by reason of sickness while in attendance as a member of the House of Representatives during the present session of the Legislature.

Chapter 46.

Resolve making appropriations for certain Military purposes.

Approved March 19, 1835.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and granted for the purposes hereinafter named, the following sums, to wit: Nine Hundred Dollars for the alteration and repair of Gun Carriages; One Hundred and Fifty Dollars for the purchase of flannel, match rope, laboratory stores and for transportation; and Five Hundred Dollars for the purchase of Musical Instruments; the several sums aforesaid to be paid, whenever in the opinion of the Governor with the advice of Council, the public service may require it.— And for the expenditure thereof the Adjutant General shall be accountable.

Chapter 47.

Resolve laying a Tax on the several Counties in this State.

Approved March 19, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the sums annexed to the several Counties, contained in the following schedule, be, and the same are hereby granted as a Tax for each County respectively, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied, for the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same, and other purposes ordered by law.
