Chapter 50.

Resolve, for the repair of the Gun-House in Wiscasset.

Approved March 19, 1835.

RESOLVED, That there be and hereby is appropriated, the sum of Fifty Dollars, to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council, for the purpose of repairing the Gun-house in Wiscasset, for the better preservation of the guns and equipments pertaining to the Wiscasset Company of Artillery.

Chapter 51.

Resolve in favor of Samuel Moulton.

Approved March 19, 1835.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Samuel Moulton from any monies not otherwise appropriated the sum of thirty one Dollars and twenty cents in full for his claim against the State for money paid for land not conveyed to him by the Land Agent.

Chapter 52.

Resolve in favor of Hall Clements.

Approved March 21, 1835.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Hall Clements the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Nine Dollars and Seventy Seven Cents, in full for costs and damage sustained by reason of two suits of Miller and Glidden, and over and above the legal costs which he recovered in said suits.
