Chapter 53.

An Additional Resolve for estublishing an Insane Hospital.

Approved March 21, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of State be and he hereby is authorized to receive from Benjamin Brown a Deed conveying to the State a Farm consisting of about two hundred acres of land with the Buildings thereon, situated partly in Vassalborough and partly in Augusta, given by said Brown in aid of the establishment of an Insane Hospital; and the Treasurer is authorized to manage, lease and dispose of the same in such manner as he shall deem most for the interest of the object for which it is given; and to make and execute, in behalf of the State, any leases and deeds necessary to carry into effect the provisions of this Resolve; and all rents, income and proceeds of said farm when received, are to be credited to the fund provided for the erection of an Insane Hospital.

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Chapter 54.

Resolve respecting the Baring and Houlton Road.

Approved March 23, 1835.

RESOLVED, That the Agent for superintending the construction of the Baring and Houlton Road be authorized to widen the same in Township number eight and the Indian Township in places where it cannot be raised sufficiently by turnpiking eighteen feet as provided by the resolve passed March 5th, 1832.
