Chapter 205.

AN ADDITIONAL ACT respecting Salaries of Judges and Registers of Probate.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That the Salary of the Judge of Probate for the County of Washington, shall be two hundred and fifty dollars in lieu of the salary now established by law, commencing on the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, *Provided* said Judge, in addition to the number of Courts now held by him, shall annually, at such time as he may appoint, hold an additional term thereof in the towns of Calais, Robbinston, Eastport, Columbia and Cherryfield.

Salary of Judge of Probate in Washington County increased to \$250.

Proviso.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That the first section of an Act passed Feb'y 21, 1828, entitled "An additional Act respecting Salaries of Judges and Registers of Probate," be and the same is hereby repealed.

Chapter 206.

AN ACT additional to "An Act for the encouragement of Agriculture, Horticulture, and Manufactures."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That so much of an Act, passed March, 1832, entitled "An Act for the encouragement of Agriculture, Horticulture and Manufactures," which provides that the monies to be paid by the Treasurer of the State to the Treasurer of any Agricultural and Horticultural Society in the month of September shall be so altered and amended, that the Treasurer of the

Treasurer of State authorized to pay monies granted to agricultural and horticultural societies, at any time in each year.
