Chapter 235.

AN ACT additional to an Act to organize govern and discipline the Militia of this State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the twenty-first section of the Act to organize, govern and discipline the Militia of this State passed March eighth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, be so far altered as to require that the annual review of the troops in Divisions, Brigades, Regiments or Battalions shall be at such times from the first day of September to the fifteenth day of October, (days of State Elections excepted) as the commanding officers of the Divisions may order.

[Approved by the Governor, March 31, 1836.]

Annual reviews may be on any day between 1st day of September and 15th day of October (days of State election excepted.)

Chapter 236.

AN ACT allowing additional pay to the Justices of the Supreme Judicial Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That there be allowed and paid out of the public Treasury, in quarterly payments, commencing on the first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, to each of the Justices of the Supreme Judicial Courts, two hundred dollars per annum in addition to the sum already authorized by law to be paid to said Justices.
