And the money thus appropriated shall be expended on said road under the superintendence of said Commissioners, or by their Agent appointed for that purpose within twelve months from the passage of this Resolve.

## Chapter 26.

Resolve authorizing a temporary loan in behalf of the State.

Approved February 25, 1836.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer be and he hereby is authorized to procure on the faith of the State a Loan of Sixty Five Thousand Dollars from the several Banks and in the proportion hereinafter named, at a rate of interest not exceeding five per centum per annum reimbursable by five annual Instalments, or at any shorter period, at the pleasure of the Government.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer is hereby authorized to call on the following named Banks for the several sums, agreeably to the provisions of a law entitled "An Act to regulate Banks and Banking," passed March 31, 1831, to wit:—Augusta—Two Thousand Dollars, Androscoggin—One Thousand Dollars, Bangor Commercial—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Bank of Bangor—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Bank of Portland—Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars, Bath Commercial—One Thousand Dollars, Bank of Cumberland—Four Thousand Dollars, Calais—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Canal—Six Thousand Dollars, Casco—Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Central—One Thousand Dollars, Citizens—One Thousand Dollars, Eastern—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Exchange—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Franklin—One Thousand Dollars, Freemans—One Thousand Dollars, Gardiner—One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars, Kenduskeag—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Lincoln—One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars, Maine—Six Thousand Dollars, Mariners—One Thousand Dollars, Manufac-

turers—One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars, Manufacturers and Traders—Two Thousand Dollars, Mercantile—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Merchants—Two Thousand Dollars, Northern—One Thousand Dollars, Peoples'—One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars, Still-water Canal—One Thousand Dollars, Skowhegan—One Thousand Dollars, South Berwick—One Thousand Dollars, Thomaston—One Thousand Dollars, Ticonic—One Thousand Dollars, Union—One Thousand Dollars, Washington County—One Thousand Dollars, Waldo—One Thousand Dollars, York—One Thousand Dollars.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer be and he hereby is directed, whenever he shall judge that the state of the public funds will allow of it without prejudice to other necessary purposes, to pay any of the Requisition Loans, made by authority of these Resolves.

**Chapter 27.**

Resolve in favor of Ichabod Bucknam.

Approved February 29, 1836.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Ichabod Bucknam the sum of twenty-seven dollars, in full for returning nine warrants of the removal of Prisoners from Washington County to the State Prison at Thomaston in the year of 1832.

**Chapter 28.**

Resolve to complete the distribution of the School Fund of One Thousand eight hundred and thirty five.

Approved February 29, 1836.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of this State be, and he hereby is authorized to apportion and distribute the balance in the Treasury of the School Fund of 1835, among the delinquent Towns of that year, basing said distribution upon the apportionment of 1836.
