Chapter 35.

Resolve for the preservation and repair of the Canada Road.

Approved March 3, 1836.

RESOLVED, That a sum not exceeding Four Hundred Dollars, be and hereby is appropriated for the preservation and repair of the Canada Road, to be expended under the direction of the Governor and Council.

Chapter 36.

Resolve in favor of Joshua Elder.

Approved March 4, 1836.

RESOLVED, That Joshua Elder be, and he is hereby authorized to select one lot of land in Indian Township number one from any of the land in said Township which may remain unsold at the time of making such selection which shall be in full satisfaction for his claim under a Resolve of the Legislature in his favor passed the nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five, and the Land Agent is hereby authorized to deed such lot of Land to said Elder *Provided however* such selection shall be made by the fourth day of July next.

Chapter 37.

Resolve authorizing the County Commissioners for the County of Penobscot to locate a road across Orson Island.

Approved March 7, 1836.

RESOLVED, That the County Commissioners for the County of Penobscot, on petition therefor, be and they are hereby authorized to lay out a highway across Orson
