**Chapter 253.**

AN ACT altering the time of holding the Court of Common Pleas, in the County of Kennebec.

Courts of Common Pleas in Kennebec County altered to first, instead of second Tuesdays of April, August and December.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Court of Common Pleas, in the County of Kennebec, from and after the next term of said Court, shall be holden annually on the first Tuesdays of April, August, and December, instead of the second Tuesdays of said months; and all matters and things, which may be pending in, or returnable to said Court, on said second Tuesdays of said months, shall be returned to, have day in, and be acted upon at the terms of said Court to be holden in pursuance of this Act.*

**Chapter 254.**

AN ADDITIONAL ACT to increase the Salary of Register of Probate in the County of Penobscot.

Salary of Register of Probate in Penobscot County, increased.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the salary of the Register of Probate, in the County of Penobscot, shall be seven hundred and fifty dollars instead of the salary now established by law, commencing on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven.*
