#### Chapter 255.

AN ACT additional to an Act, establishing salaries for Judges and Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the salary of the Register of Probate for the County salary of Register of Washington shall hereafter be four hundred and washington co. Fifty Dollars instead of the salary now established increased. by law.

[Approved by the Governor February 13, 1837.]

#### Chapter 256.

AN ADDITIONAL ACT to provide for the education of Youth.

Section 1.
