#### Chapter 288.

AN ACT relative to tenants in common.

common ant, &c.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. That Any tenant in from and after the passage of this Act, any tenant maintain an action of quae in common of lands or tenements, may maintain an clausum fregit against his coten action of trespass quae clausum fregit, against his cotenant who shall prevent his entering or occupying such lands or tenements, as may be held by them in common.
