Chapter 293.

AN ACT repealing an additional Act regulating the inspection of Beef and Pork.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. That an Act entitled "an additional Act Repeal of "An regulating the inspection of Beef and Pork," approved March sixth one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, be and the same hereby is repealed.

additional Act regulating the inspection of Beef, &c." approved March 6, 1835.

entitled "An additional Act regulating the inspection of Beef and Pork" approved March 28, 1837.

Be it further enacted, That the SECT. 2. Also of the 2d section of an Act entitled "an additional Act regulating the inspection of Beef and Pork" approved March twenty-eight, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one be and the same hereby is revived.

[Approved by the Governor March 29, 1837.]

Chapter 294.

AN ACT in addition to an Act entitled an "Act to relieve the public from the burden of Tolls at Back Cove Bridge."

Be it enacted by the Senate and SECTION 1. House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That from and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful for the proprietors of Back Cove Bridge aforesaid to demand or receive toll of or from any person or persons for passing or repassing said Bridge, and any person or persons may pass and repass said Bridge either on foot, or with horses, carriages, teams or otherwise, without paying toll therefor.

Sect. 2. Be it further enacted, That any person who shall as Agent or in the name or by the authority of said proprietors of Back Cove Bridge or in any capacity, demand or receive any toll from

Proprietors of Back Cove Bridge prohibited from receiving toll.
