Chapter 302.

AN ACT relating to Fees received by the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the Secretary of State be and hereby is entitled to the fees received in his office; and that so much of an Act, passed March nineteenth, one thousand eight hundred and twenty, as relates thereto, be, and the same is hereby repealed; and that the Treasurer of State is authorized to refund to said Secretary of State, such fees as he has paid into the Treasury since the thirty-first day of December last.

Secretary of State allowed to retain to his own use the fees received in his office, &c. &c.

Chapter 303.

AN ACT additional, relative to the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the Inspectors shall in the month of January annually audit, correct and settle the accounts of the Warden with the Prison, and with the State, for the year ending the last day of December preceding and make report to the Governor and Council in said month—any thing in the several Acts, to which this is additional, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Inspectors of the State Prison shall in the month of January annually audit and settle the account of the Warden with the Prison and with the State, &c. and make report to the Governor and Council.
