Chapter 293.

AN ACT to incorporate the Frenchman's Bay Granite Company.

Approved March 17, 1837.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Charles H. Pierpont, Nathaniel Hobart, E. T. Aldrick, Brazilla Latham, James Auchincloss and their associates, successors and assigns, be and they hereby are created a corporation by the name of the Frenchman's Bay Granite Company, for the purpose of quarrying, getting out, preparing, transporting and shipping, granite and erecting wharves and machinery on their own land; and also of engaging in such branches of trade and business as may be necessarily and usually connected therewith; and for these purposes shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and requirements contained in the several Acts now in force in this State, defining the general powers and duties of manufacturing corporations and may take and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding, at any one time, in the whole the value of two hundred thousand dollars.
