#### Chapter 327.

AN AC'I' to incorporate the New York and New Orleans Union Granite Company.

Approved March 21, 1837.

Corporators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That Ira D. Bugbee, George Purington, Stephen Merrill, Charles Tebbetts, and Horace Ward, their associates successors and assigns, be and they hereby are created a corporation, by the name Corporate name of the New York and New Orleans Union Granite Company, for the purpose of quarrying, manufacturing and dealing in granite and other stone upon their own land in the towns of Biddeford and Kennebunk and of exporting the same to market with power to hold and manage real and personal estate not exceeding at any one time one hund-And said corporation shall be red thousand dollars. vested with all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the restrictions and liabilities, now in force by the existing laws of this State regulating corporations, and the provisions of an Act upon the same subject, passed sixteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thous-
