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**Chapter 384.**

AN ACT to incorporate the Steuben and Harrington Granite Company.

Approved March 29, 1837.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled,* That William Freeman, Corporators.  
 Abner Johnson and Robert Foster and their associates successors and assigns be, and they hereby are created a corporation by the name of the Steuben and Harrington Granite Company, for the purpose of quarrying, getting out, preparing, transporting and shipping granite and erecting wharves and machinery on their own land, and for these purposes shall have all the powers and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and requirements contained in the several Acts now in force in this State, defining the general powers and duties of manufacturing corporations, and may take and hold real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding at any one time in the whole, the value of fifty thousand dollars. Corporate name. Powers, &c. Capital Stock,—\$50,000.
