**Chapter 59.**

Resolve authorizing a loan of money.

Approved March 29, 1837.

**RESOLVED**, That the Treasurer of State be, and hereby is authorized to obtain on the credit and faith of the State, a loan of money not exceeding the sum of One Hundred and Fifty-five Thousand Dollars in the whole, at a rate of interest not exceeding five per centum annually, the one half thereof reimbursable at the pleasure of the State after five years and the other half at the pleasure of the State after eight years.

**RESOLVED**, That the Treasurer be, and he hereby is required to appropriate the monies obtained in virtue of the foregoing Resolve, as fast as the same shall be received, towards the discharge of the debts which may be due from the State to the several Banks.

**Chapter 60.**

Resolve authorizing the County Commissioners for the County of Cumberland to locate a road over tide waters between Westbrook and Portland.

Approved March 29, 1837.

**RESOLVED**, That the County Commissioners for the County of Cumberland be and they hereby are authorized and empowered to locate a County road over tide waters from Portland to Westbrook on or near Tukey's Bridge, so called, if they shall adjudge that the public convenience and necessity requires such location; *Provided, however* that no proceedings had by said County Commissioners under the authority of this Resolve shall impose any liability upon the town of Westbrook or the County of Cumberland to make or keep in repair said road.

**Chapter 61.**

**RESOLVES** providing for the sale of Gun Houses, and the exchange of Gun House Sites, in East Machias and Calais.

Approved March 29, 1837.

**RESOLVED**, That the Acting Quarter Master General be, and he hereby is authorized to dispose of the State's

Gun Houses in East Machias and Calais, either at public or private sale ; and the nett proceeds of the sales shall be paid into the Treasury of the State.

RESOLVED, That the Acting Quarter Master General be, and he hereby is authorized to exchange the lots of land on which the State's Gun Houses now stand, in the towns of East Machias and Calais, for other lots, and to execute a legal transfer of the State's right to said land, if, in his opinion, such exchange would be for the interest of the State.

### Chapter 62.

Resolve authorizing the Treasurer of the County of Washington to borrow money on the faith of said County.

Approved March 29, 1837.

RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of the County of Washington, be and he hereby is authorized to negotiate a loan, on the faith and responsibility of said County, not exceeding Two Thousand Dollars, to meet the current expenses of said County :—and this Resolve shall be in force one year and no longer.

### Chapter 63.

Resolves authorizing the distribution of the first Report of the Geology of Maine.

Approved March 29, 1837.

RESOLVED, That there shall be copies of the First Report of the Geological Survey of Maine distributed in the following manner—viz:—Twelve copies to the Governor of the State. One copy to each member of the Council, Senate and House of Representatives. One copy to the Secretary of the State, Treasurer, Land Agent and Adjutant General. One copy to the Secretary, Assistant Secretary and Messengers of the Senate. One copy
