#### Chapter 341.

#### Chapter 342.

AN ADDITIONAL ACT regulating divorces.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That divorces from matrifrom the bands of matrimony may be decreed, in case mony in case either party beeither of the parties is or shall hereafter become a con-drunkard and firmed and common drunkard, and shall so continue continue for three years. for the space of three years, thereby incapacitating him or herself from making suitable provision for or taking proper care of his or her family.
