Chapter 356.

AN ACT additional to the several Acts now in force, to organize, govern and discipline the Militia of this State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the second and third sections of an Act entitled "An Act additional second and third to the several Acts now in force, to organize, govern mer Act repeal and discipline the Militia of this State," passed the ed. twenty-third day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight, to which this Act is additional, be, and the same are hereby repealed.
