Chapter 432.

AN ACT ADDITIONAL to an Act incorporating the Bangor Insurance Company.

Approved March 6, 1838.

Extension of
time for payment
of 2d instalment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That a further time of three years from and after the first day of April next, be and hereby is granted to the Bangor Insurance Company to pay in the second installment of the capital stock of said company.

Chapter 433.

AN ACT ADDITIONAL to an "Act to incorporate the Damariscotta Steam Navigation Company."

Approved March 6, 1838.

Extension of two
years for putting
in operation said
boat.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That a further time of two years from and after the passing of this Act, shall be allowed to the proprietors of the Damariscotta Steam Navigation Company; to complete and to put into operation a steam boat, which they were authorized to build and put into operation on Damariscotta Pond, by an Act of the Legislature of this State, approved March nineteenth, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, without forfeiting their charter or losing any powers, privileges or immunities granted them by said Act.

Chapter 434.

AN ACT to incorporate the Liberty Granular Quartz and Glass Company.
