SECT. 5. *Be it further enacted*, That the Legislature may alter or amend the provisions of this Act or any part thereof at pleasure.

First meeting.

SECT. 6. *Be it further enacted*, That John Ham is hereby authorized to fix the time and place of holding the first meeting of said board of Trustees and to notify them thereof accordingly.

AN ACT to incorporate the Vassalborough Manufacturing Company.

Approved March 22, 1833.

First meeting.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled*, That Peter M. Stackpole, Alton Pope, their associates, successors, and assigns be, and they are hereby incorporated into a company by the name of the Vassalboro' Manufacturing Company for the purpose of manufacturing wool and cotton, in the County of Kennebec with power to take and hold any estate real or personal to an amount not exceeding, at any one time, the value of seventy-five thousand dollars, and said company shall have all the powers and privileges, granted to similar corporations subject to all the duties and requirements, contained in the several Acts defining the general powers and duties of manufacturing corporations, and also to an Act concerning corporations, passed the sixteenth day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted*, That the first meeting of the corporation may be called by either of the aforementioned persons, by giving notice of the time and place thereof in such way as they may deem proper.
