Chapter 488.

AN ACT in addition to an Act entitled an Act to incorporate the Jonesborough and Whiteyville Railroad Company.

Approved March 23, 1833.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That unless the railroads, mentioned in the Act to which this is additional, shall be completed in three years from the time of the passing of this Act, then so much of the Act to which this is additional as relates to said railroads, shall be void, and not otherwise, any thing in the Act to which this is additional to the contrary notwithstanding.

Railroads to be completed in 3 years.

Chapter 489.

AN ACT to correct the State valuation.

Approved March 23, 1833.

Whereas by an Act entitled an Act to annex part of the town of Hallowell to the town of Gardiner passed February twenty-fourth one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four a portion of the town of Hallowell commonly called Bowman's Point was set off from said town of Hallowell and annexed to the town of Gardiner—therefore

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled,* That fifty polls and thirty-two thousand, three hundred and six dollars and eighty-three cents be deducted from said town of Hallowell on the State valuation and that the same be transferred to said town of Gardiner; and that in future all assessments on said towns be on the valuation as thus altered.

Fifty polls and \$32,306 83 to be deducted from Hallowell and transferred to Gardiner.

SECT. 2. *Be it further enacted,* That so much of the Act aforesaid passed February twenty-fourth one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four as is inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, be and the same is hereby repealed.
