CHAPTER 43.

Resolve in favor of Albert Wyer.

Approved March 15, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Albert Wyer of Minot, Seventy-five Dollars, in remuneration for an injury sustained by him, while doing military duty.

CHAPTER 44.

Resolve in favor of Peter Lambard.

Approved March 15, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Peter Lambard of Turner the sum of Fifty-six Dollars which sum is to be in full of all claims the said Lambard has against the State for injuries sustained by his son while on military duty.

CHAPTER 45.

Resolve in favor of Andrew Cole.

Approved March 15, 1838.

RESOLVED, For reasons set forth in his petition, there be paid to Andrew Cole of Corinna the sum of One Hundred and Sixty-three Dollars; and that a warrant be drawn therefor.

CHAPTER 46.

Resolve in favor of John Baker, Walter Powers, Nathaniel Bartlett, Augustine Webster, Isaac Yearington and John Harford, Jun'r.

Approved, March 19, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and paid out of the
