**CHAPTER 43.**

Resolve in favor of Albert Wyer.

Approved March 15, 1838.

**RESOLVED,** That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Albert Wyer of Minot, Seventy-five Dollars, in remuneration for an injury sustained by him, while doing military duty.

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**CHAPTER 44.**

Resolve in favor of Peter Lambard.

Approved March 15, 1838.

**RESOLVED,** That there be paid out of the Treasury of the State to Peter Lambard of Turner the sum of Fifty-six Dollars which sum is to be in full of all claims the said Lambard has against the State for injuries sustained by his son while on military duty.

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**CHAPTER 45.**

Resolve in favor of Andrew Cole.

Approved March 15, 1838.

**RESOLVED,** For reasons set forth in his petition, there be paid to Andrew Cole of Corinna the sum of One Hundred and Sixty-three Dollars; and that a warrant be drawn therefor.

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**CHAPTER 46.**

Resolve in favor of John Baker, Walter Powers, Nathaniel Bartlett, Augustine Webster, Isaac Yearington and John Harford, Jun'r.
