CHAPTER 76.

An Additional Resolve for payment of the Bounty on Wheat.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and paid from the Treasury of the State, to the Treasurers of the several cities, towns, and plantations, mentioned in the "additional Roll of Accounts No. 1, for payment of the Bounty on Wheat," the sums set against their names respectively, amounting in the aggregate, to the sum of three hundred fifty-nine dollars and thirty-six cents in full discharge of said accounts.
