CHAPTER 77.

Resolve in favor of Mary Riggs.

Approved, March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That the Land Agent be and he hereby is required to convey to Mary Riggs Lot numbered One in the Town of Greenbush in the County of Penobscot to have and to hold the same to the said Mary, during the period of her natural life, and then to descend to her heirs; and said lot of land shall not be liable to be attached or levied upon for the payment of any debts which the said Mary now owes or may hereafter contract, or which may be due from the estate of her former husband or any future husband if she should ever marry again, and shall not be subject to be conveyed or alienated by said Mary, she paying for said land Five Dollars at the time of said conveyance.
