340 FRANKLIN AND PISCATAQUIS PORTER'S CHARTS.

State to William Dickey, for services as Brigade Major the sum of Twenty-five Dollars—to Louis T. Cushing, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars for services as Adjutant second Regiment, first Brigade, fourth Division—to Treasurer of the town of Salem for bounty paid for one Wolf's head, Fifteen Dollars—to Solomon Nash, Jr. Two Dollars and Eighty Cents in addition to the sum allowed him by the Committee on Accounts for his attendance before a Committee of the Legislature.

CHAPTER 83.

Resolve in favor of the Counties of Franklin and Piscataquis.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars, be and the same is hereby granted as a tax for the County of Franklin, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses of said County, and such other purposes ordered by law for the year eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, provided the Act establishing the said County of Franklin, should take effect, at the time and manner prescribed in said Act and not otherwise.

RESOLVED, That the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars, be and the same is hereby granted, as a tax for the County of Piscataquis, to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses of said County, and such other purposes ordered by law for the year eighteen hundred and thirty-eight.

CHAPTER 84.

Resolve for the purchase and distribution of Porter's new and improved Chart of the Coast of Maine.

Approved, March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That the Secretary of State is hereby authorized to purchase Fifty sets of Porter's new and improved Chart of the Coast of Maine, at a price not exceeding Eight Dollars per Set.
