CHAPTER 94.

Resolve in favor of Joseph E. Shorey.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury of this State to Joseph E. Shorey of Fowler Gore, in the County of Washington, the sum of Nine Dollars and Sixty-eight Cents, it being a bounty on wheat raised by him during the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven.

CHAPTER 95.

Resolve in favor of Nathaniel Hanscom.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That the State Treasurer be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay Nathaniel Hanscom of Dixmont, one of the members of the House of Representatives, the sum of Fifteen Dollars, it being expenses incurred by him for medical attendance during this Session.

CHAPTER 96.

Resolve in favor of Joseph Wardwell.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That the Land Agent be and hereby is authorized to convey by deed to Joseph Wardwell or his assigns the lot of land in Township numbered Two, of the Indian Purchase to which the said Wardwell was entitled by a certificate numbered one hundred and twenty-one, issued by the Land Agent on the fifth day of September, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, under the provisions of the "Resolve in favor of certain officers and soldiers of the Revolutionary War and the widows of the deceased officers and soldiers," approved March seventeenth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, the said certificate having been lost.
