RESOLVED, That there be paid to the several persons named in the above and preceding Roll, the sum set against their names respectively, amounting, in the whole, to the sum of Five Thousand Four Hundred and Sixty-three Dollars.

CHAPTER 106.

Resolve in favor of Ingraham Duncan.

Approved March 23, 1838.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the Treasury the sum of Twenty-five Dollars, to Ingraham Duncan, a member of the House of Representatives, for accidental injury done to his person, and the Governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasury for the same.
