### Chapter 371.

AN ACT additional to "An Act for the protection of the Mattanawcook and Military Roads."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That any Carts or WARDONS drawn by two cart or wagon, drawn by two horses or two oxen only, and carrying a load not exceeding fifteen hun-dred pounds, may pass over any part of the Matta-nawcook State road or Military road, in this State, hit with a load not exceeding fifteen hun-teen hundred opass over the Matanawcook any thing in the act to which this is additional to roads. the contrary notwithstanding.
