trial, and such witness having no reasonable excuse to the contrary, shall neglect to appear and attend said Court and testify as aforesaid, every such person so neglecting and refusing, shall forfeit and pay the sum of three hundred dollars to any person, whether an inhabitant of this State or not, who shall sue, in an action of debt, for the same in this State; *Provided however*, that no such witness shall, by virtue of any such summons, be compelled to travel a greater distance from his home than five hundred miles.

Chapter 383.

AN ACT establishing the Salaries of the Judge and Register of Probate for the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That the salary for the Judge of Probate for the County of Piscataquis be and the same is hereby established at sixty dollars; and the salary of the Register of Probate for said County be, and the same hereby is established at one hundred and twenty-five dollars per year.

Chapter 384.

AN ACT requiring Toll Bridges which are, or may be covered to be suitably lighted.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled*, That all Toll Bridges, which are now built or which may be hereafter built within this State and which are, or hereafter may be, in whole or in part
