Chapter 542.

AN ACT to change the names of certain persons.

Approved March 14, 1839.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That William Dodge of Salem be allowed to take the name of William Warren Dodge, that Birtha Littlefield of Belgrade be allowed to take the name of Clarrenda Frances Littlefield, that Elizabeth Frances Jones of Minot be allowed to take the name of Elizabeth Frances Bridgham, that Xoa McLaughlin of Augusta be allowed to take the name of Ellen McLaughlin, that Amasa Parker of Bucksport be allowed to take the name of Amasa Wellington Parker, that John Davis of Portland be allowed to take the name of John Y. Davis, that William T. Brown of Gorham be allowed to take the name of Ezra Thombs, that George Rogers 3d of Phipsburg be allowed to take the name of George Langdon Rogers, that Lyman E. Woodcock of Winthrop be allowed to take the name of Lyman Evans Davis, that Harry Dwelly of Carmel be allowed to take the name of Henry Dwelly, that Joseph Causins of Ellsworth be allowed to take the name of Andrew P. Causins, that Hannah Videto of New Vineyard and her children, viz: Nelson, Jane, Emily, Caroline, Eliza and Andrew Videto be allowed to take the name of Bates for their surname, that John Whitney jr. of Searsmont, be allowed to take the name of John F. Whitney, that Harriet Bragg of China be allowed to take the name of Harriet Clark, that Temperance Harding Fenno of Gorham be allowed to take the name of Charlotte Harding Fenno, that Wesley Beedle of Richmond be allowed to take the name of Charles Wesley Beedle, that Stephen Shehan of Biddeford be allowed to take the name of Stephen Neal.
