Chapter 549.

AN ACT to change the name of Joshua Richardson.

Approved March 21, 1839.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, That Joshua Richardson of Portland in the County of Cumberland be allowed to take the name of Joshua Wingate Richardson.

Chapter 550.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Masardis.

Approved March 21, 1839.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in Legislature assembled, That the township numbered ten, in the fifth Range on the Aroostook river in the County of Aroostook bounded on the North by township numbered eleven, in the fifth Range, on the East by township numbered ten, in the fourth Range, on the South by township numbered nine in the fifth Range, and on the West by township numbered ten in the sixth Range, with the inhabitants thereof, be, and the same hereby is, incorporated into a town by the name of Masardis.*

Boundaries.

SEC. 2. *Be it further enacted, That any Justice of the Peace for said County may issue his warrant, directing some person resident in said town, to notify the inhabitants thereof to meet, at a time and place, in said warrant specified, for the choice of town officers.*
