#### Chapter 27.

Resolve in relation to the North Eastern Boundary.

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That the Governor be authorized to appoint, when circumstances in his opinion require it, some person or persons to supply, temporarily, the place of the Land Agent, in executing the Resolve of the twenty-fourth January last, relating to trespassers on the Public Lands. And the person or persons thus appointed, shall, for the time being, have all the power, and be subject to all the duties of Land Agent, so far as it regards the Resolve aforesaid.

#### Chapter 28.

Resolve for the erection of a Gun House in Garland,

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be erected under the direction of the Governor and Council a Gun House in Garland in the County of Penobscot, *Provided*, That the expense thereof shall not exceed two hundred and fifty dollars and that a suitable site therefor be conveyed to the State to be held for such term as said site may be occupied for the purpose of a Gun House.

### Chapter 29.

Resolve for the erection of a Gun House in Lincoln.

Approved February 16, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars for the erection of a Gun House in Lincoln in the County of Penobscot to be expended under the direction and at the discretion of the Governor and Council—Provided, that a suitable site therefor be conveyed to the State to be held for such term as said site may be occupied for the purpose of a Gun House.
