#### Chapter 37.

#### Resolve authorizing the County Commissioners for Hancock County to hire money for certain purposes.

### Approved February 25, 1839.

**RESOLVED**, That the County Commissioners for the County of Hancock be and they hereby are authorized to borrow, in behalf of said County, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent. per annum, the sum of Three Thousand Four Hundred and Thirty-Eight Dollars, for the purpose of discharging the debts of the County incurred in erecting and fitting up suitable buildings, for the accommodation of the Judicial Courts of said County. The interest on said sum to be paid by said County annually, and the principal, or sum so borrowed, to be reimbursed in two equal instalments,---to wit :---One half in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, and the remainder in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight-and the said Commissioners are authorized and required to add the said annual interest and the said instalments to the ordinary expenses of the appropriate years, and assess the same with the yearly taxes.

### Chapter 38.

#### Resolve in favor of Apollos R. Gilmore.

# Approved February 25, 1839.

**RESOLVED**, That the State Treasurer be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to pay Apollos R. Gilmore of Newburg, One Hundred Seven Dollars and Thirty Cents, it being for expenses incurred in defending an action brought against-him as Collector of Taxes, and failed in consequence of the Legislature changing the State paper after he had advertised for sale certain non-resident lands taxed in his bills—and the Governor with advice of Council be and he hereby is authorized to draw his warrant on the Treasurer for the same.
