Chapter 97.

Resolve in favor of James B. Cahoon.

Approved March 22, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be paid out of the the Treasury of this State, to James B. Cahoon, One Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars for extra services as clerk in the Treasury Department.

Chapter 98.

Resolve relating to the State Prison.

Approved March 23, 1839.

RESOLVED, That the Governor, with the advice of the Council, be, and hereby is authorized to appoint some persons to erect a temporary Stockade around the yard of the State Prison, so as to enclose the site of the contemplated wall around the Prison Yard, agreeably to a plan reported by the Commissioners appointed by Resolve of March 20, 1838.
