Chapter 120.

Resolve on the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives.

Approved March 23, 1839.

RESOLVED, That there be allowed and paid out of the Treasury of this State, to the several persons named in the Pay Roll of the House of Representatives of the Nineteenth Legislature of the State of Maine, the sums set against their respective names on said Pay Roll, amounting to Thirty Four Thousand, Ninety One Dollars and Sixty cents.
